THE STORY:

Goldilocks and the three....PIGS? The action in this playful romp features Goldilocks, the three pigs called the Chop Brothers and their friends the Squeal Sisters on an epic adventure! Toss into this hilarious fractured fairytale the Big Bad Wolf, his French weasel friend Oui Oui and two very different witches, then mix in a classic chase scene and a little bit of a moral and watch the mayhem that ensues!

CASTING:

Adults, age 18-65 and youth, ages 6-up; all ethnicities.

NOTE: All gender identities and ethnicities will be considered for casting of this show. The ages listed are approximate. Actors cast should be able to "play" these ages. In reference to the character descriptions below – The characters in this show are on the binary and written with he/him or she/her pronouns as you will see in the following descriptions. However, we seek to be as inclusive as possible and ask gender non-conforming, gender queer, transgender and non-binary actors to list on the audition form the roles they most identify with. Actors should list any and all roles they identify with on their audition form regardless of a character's presumed gender or ethnicity.

CHARACTERS :

Goldilocks

She is spunky and sweet; suffering from first love and mother issues; not always truthful

Age: 14-25

Storyteller

Has an inflated opinion of herself; does not like changes in the story; sarcastic

Age: 25-up

Pork Chop

He owns the brick house; levelheaded: keeps the peace between Curly and Fuzzy

Age: 10-20

Curly Chop

Big & Gruff; at odds with Fuzzy most of the time; his house was made of wood

Age: 10-20

Fuzzy Chop

Straight-laced; wears glasses; his house was made of straw

Age: 10-20

Rose Hips Squeal

Eldest sister; very mothering, especially towards Goldilocks

Age: 10-20

Patti Squeal

Middle sister; talkative; loves to perform; has her eye on Fuzzy

Age: 10-20

Laverne Squeal

Not the sharpest knife in the drawer; youngest of the three sisters

Age: 10-20

Witch Wanda

Goldilocks' mother; not a traditional-looking witch; dressed attractively; sure of herself

Age: 35-65

Sandy Witch

Much more of a traditional-looking witch; wears a large witch nose-the bigger the better; friendly and fun

Age: 35-65

Wolf

Pretty standard wolf type-smart, slick and determined

Age: 20-65

Weasel

Second fiddle to Wolf; speaks with an over-the-top but understandable French accent (which does not have to be good!)

Age: 10-25

Chad

Surfer-dude skateboarder type

Age: 14-25

Little Red

She wears a red hood

Age: 10-20

Ensemble/Wood Nymphs

Play various roles

Age: 6-65
